**(CHARLOTTE)** - U.S. Representative Sue Myrick (NC-9) will present a \$25,000 grant on behalf of The UPS Foundation to Community Link CEO Floyd Davis before a large audience of UPS employees. The grant will be used to enable individuals and families obtain and sustain safe, decent and affordable housing in the greater Charlotte region. The event will be held at 8:30 am Monday, March 28<sup>th</sup>, at the Charlotte UPS headquarters. The UPS Foundation is a charitable arm of UPS (NYSE:UPS).

Community Link, a Charlotte-based non-profit organization, has worked for 81 years to provide effective individualized long-term services to break the cycle of poverty among area citizens. Last year 376 individuals and families became homeowners through their Homeownership Program and 210 formerly homeless families were placed in rental housing.
